Notes on the Stats:

- 1. Charlotte Homeschooling has a well balanced method of receiving traffic. Our site traffic comes about evenly from
 - a. **46.9% Direct Hits** (people know about us and come to site directly) This is usually a sign that people come to the site more than once.
 - b. **7.4% Referral** (people come to us from other sites who have links to charlottehomeschooling.com)
 - c. **44.6% Natural Search Engine Traffic** (search engines have found charlottehomeschooling.com without us paying for it) This is a strong factor since we do not advertise on the search engines, they find us naturally.
- 2. Charlottehomeschooling.com has a very low overall bounce rate (a bounce is a visitor coming to a site and immediately leaving within about 10 seconds) Charlotte Homeschooling keeps visitors attention long enough to get them involved with the site.


